Harisiddhi Community Learning Center serves as a hub for adult literacy and skill development among housewives from low-income families. The center also provides tutorial classes for their children, conducted by volunteer teachers. Additionally, the women manufacture handmade bags to support their families economically.

Support Requested

The community has identified the following needs:

1. **Two low-height tables (2' x 4')**
 - o Estimated cost: Rs 10,000, to be temporarily transferred from Remaining fund of Project account at Himalayan Bank Ltd.
2. **Carpet for the floor (250 sq. ft.)**
 - o Contribution: Contributed by Rtn. Indira N Joshi
3. **Two whiteboards (3'X5')**
 - o Contribution: One contributed by Rtn. Indira N Joshi and another by Rtn. Rupak Das Tamrakar.
